

CARNAGILL COMMUNITY PRIMARY SCHOOL

Admissions Policy

Our Foundation Stage 1 class (Nursery) caters for up to 26 children who are aged 3+ at the start of each term. Children attend on a part-time basis, each morning, from 8.50am-11.50am and can attend on the day after their third birthday.

Full-time education begins in September for all children who will be 5 years old in that academic year.

It is helpful if prospective parents contact the school to make arrangements for a school visit prior to entry and to provide us with as much information as possible relating to their children including reports and work from the previous school.

Children will be admitted to this school under the following order of priority:

First Priority

Children with a statement of special educational needs, which names this school.

Second Priority

Children in Public Care for whom the school has been expressed as a preference. This applies to all looked-after children, including those who are in the care of another local authority.

Third Priority

Children we believe have special social or medical reasons for admission. Applications will only be considered if they are supported by a professional recommendation from a doctor, social worker or other appropriate professional which says that it is essential for your child to go to this school and no other.

Fourth Priority

Children living within the normal area of this school.

Fifth Priority

Children living outside the normal area of this school.

If there are not enough places for all the children in one of these priority groups, we will give priority first to those with brothers or sisters at the school in September of each academic year and then to those living nearest to school.
