Please be aware it is the responsibility of parents to ensure their children are adequately supervised before and after school while on the school grounds. Please ensure that children do not play unsupervised on the tyres and the adventure play area before and after school.

If you are changing the collection arrangements for your child and want a different adult to pick them up you must let us know.

Children from Y3 upwards are allowed to leave the school building and find their adult on the playground. We will remind children after the break that if they cannot see their adult they must come back into school.

Concerns

If you are in anyway concerned about your child/ren's learning, progress or wellbeing in school please contact school via the office. Class teachers are always the best people to speak to first, as they know you child/ren very well. If it is a more serious matter then the Key stage Leaders; Mrs Barker (EYFS), Mrs Brown (KS1) or Mrs Bradshaw (KS2) are the next contact and then myself.

If you feel a concern is on-going or has not been addressed please contact school and ask to speak to me.

If your child is absent from school for any reason please remember to let the admin team know before 9am. Until we know the reason for absence we cannot authorise absence. If you are requesting leave for a child during term time we may ask for further information from Unit Welfare Officers or employers.
